The activities in this brochure are designed to assist you in helping the message to be sealed in your heart and in your families' lives all week long.

This brochure is far from comprehensive. As you read and teach these ideas to your children, it is our prayer that God will begin to give you more creative ideas in leading your children to God's Word.

Write the memory verse from Proverbs ("Trust in the Lord with all your heart." - Proverbs 3:5) on a piece of paper and post it on your refrigerator as a reminder of God's ever-present help. Memorize the passage and where it is found in the Bible.

Share with your children stories about how God delivered you from an impossible looking situation.

Did you follow any of the 5 P's: Pray, Plan, Be Persistent, Pursue, and find the Purpose for the giant in your life?

Watch "Facing the Giants" as a family. At the end, try to find the 5 P's, Pray, Plan, Be Persistent, Pursue and find the Purpose of the trial.
Go to 1 Peter 1: 6 & 7

Watch for opportunities to remind your children that, "Nothing is impossible with God."

Drama:

As a parent, I am Goliath and the child is David.
All they need is a shoestring, small towel, piece of clothing or anything that can serve as a pretend sling shot. (Try to use something that is soft, something that will not leave a mark if it is accidentally swung in the direction of other family members. A small marshmallow is a good object for the stone.)

The story goes:

I AM GOLIATH OF THE
PHILISTINES! WHO ARE YOU?

David of the Israelites.
I HAVE A BIG SWORD AND SHIELD TO FIGHT WITH!
WHAT DO YOU HAVE?

Five stones and a sling.

FIVE STONES AND A SLING DON'T SCARE ME! I'M
COMING AFTER YOU. (Step forward)

(The child swings the pretend sling.)

AWGGGG! YOU GOT ME (Fall down.)

(The child walks up to the fallen Goliath.) My God has protected me!

If you have various aged children, expand the drama with the whole family playing different parts. You can have the smallest play David and the biggest play Goliath.

Cast someone in the role of King Saul and someone in the role of David's brothers.

While reading 1 Samuel 17, stop at the places the various characters can act out. For example, David's brother telling him to: "Go home and tend to the sheep".

Simple playacting can create a lasting impression. Try it!
