**Shame On You**

I. Shame Vs. Guilt

A. Guilt: The feeling we have done something wrong it helps us set moral boundaries in conjunction with our consciences which we call conviction.

*“For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you.”* Romans 12:3 NIV

B. Shame: When our actions result in defining ourselves as a bad person, not good enough and not valuable and we accept it

II. Shame Roots:

A. Shame: may have come from past young childhood experience that an authority figure did to you or spoke into your life

B. Shame: may have been passed down from a generational sin or curse

*The Lord is slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, forgiving iniquity and transgression, but he will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, to the third and the fourth generation.'*

*Numbers 14:18 NIV*

III. Adam and Eve: Genesis 3:

A. Shame shows itself Gen. 3:6

B. Shame mixes with the fear that God might find out their sin Gen. 3:7 NIV

C. Fear Opens the door to controlling the Situation Gen. 3: 8-9 NIV

D. If control is threatened we rebel  
Gen. 3: 10-11 NIV

E. Rebellion leads to rejection and we withdraw so that our shame is not exposed.  
Gen. 3:23-24 NIV

F. Each influence provides an open door for the other influences in the network

S. F. C. is like wearing layers of masks hiding their true identity

IV. Freedom from the Blockade

A. The Cross gives us victory over shame  
“...For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.”  
Hebrews 12:2 NIV

B. We receive the rights and privileges of being called a Son Of God which includes the Authority of Jesus Christ
