After The Message

1. Parents you may want some quiet time to meditate and pray over the suggestions above.

Ask God to show you if you have any ungodly beliefs coming from how you were raised. Have God examine you to see if you have any generational sins / curses in your family.

Ask forgiveness for things God shows you, either in your family or your lives.

If God shows you legal rights that Satan has claims to in your life, renounce them.

If God shows you ungodly beliefs you have passed on to your children, break it by asking your children to forgive you for your ungodly belief.

2. Movie Night: Take a night this week and watch “The Incredibles”.

Review the message during or afterwards showing how the hurt and pain caused spiritual bondage in their lives.

3. Play the game of Risk. (probably something you could do with older children) In the game of Risk, territories are taken over. Talk about the principle of giving up territory to Satan as you play and the Spirit of God shows you concepts in the game about giving up your territory.

4. Play a game of tag, as you tag someone they join your team. This could also illustrate the power of territory that the game of risk shows the older children.

Another idea is when there are Godly beliefs and less ungodly beliefs it is like being ganged up on. So we need to fill our minds with Godly beliefs from God's Word.

5. If someone needs first aid this week—talk about how hurts can create ungodly beliefs in your life. Explain to them that the hurt will only last a short time, if treated with the proper medicine.
